Salaries are in the range of CI\$35,000 to CI\$50,000 depending on experience. (The Cayman dollar is 20% more than the US dollar and there is no income tax in the Cayman Islands). A relocation allowance which includes return airfare, medical plan (the School pays for coverage of the employee only; employee must pay premiums for any dependant/s), pension plan, and induction course are provided.
